The Marotta-Mondolfo Committee

In 1987, the CRI (Italian Red Cross) movement was born in Marotta, thanks to the dedication and determination of its founder, Marcello Seri. In 1988, following an order from the extraordinary commissioner of CRI, the delegation of Mondolfo-Marotta was established. In the following years, many individuals mobilized to ensure that the Volontari del Soccorso (Volunteers of Relief) could carry out their activities.

Numerous rescue vehicles were donated by companies, banks, and citizens, and every day, the volunteers worked tirelessly to assist and support the sick, injured, disabled, and elderly. They also provided first aid services at sporting, cultural, and folk events.



Context & Environment

AIM

The aim of the Consortium is to conduct various activities related to health, social health, and education. Additionally, it focuses on providing training in health-related matters both internally and externally. The Consortium also manages public green areas, nature reserves, and engages in activities related to tourism, sports, protection, and civil service.

Furthermore, the Consortium is formed and constituted by consortium members who are primarily affiliated with the Italian Red Cross (CRI) Committees in the Province of Pesaro Urbino. In summary, the Consortium's purpose is to carry out a diverse range of initiatives and services that contribute to the well-being and development of the community, with a strong focus on health and social welfare.



Attivit ies

Our organization offers a fulfilling role for young individuals as escort volunteers, where you'll transport children and the elderly to healthcare facilities. You'll be part of a supportive team, with opportunities to explore various regions. Your role involves safely pushing wheelchairs and providing comfort, but it's also about compassionate interaction. Initial comprehensive training and optional courses within the CRI will enhance your skills like empathy, communication, and teamwork. This volunteer opportunity promises personal growth and the chance to positively impact lives.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

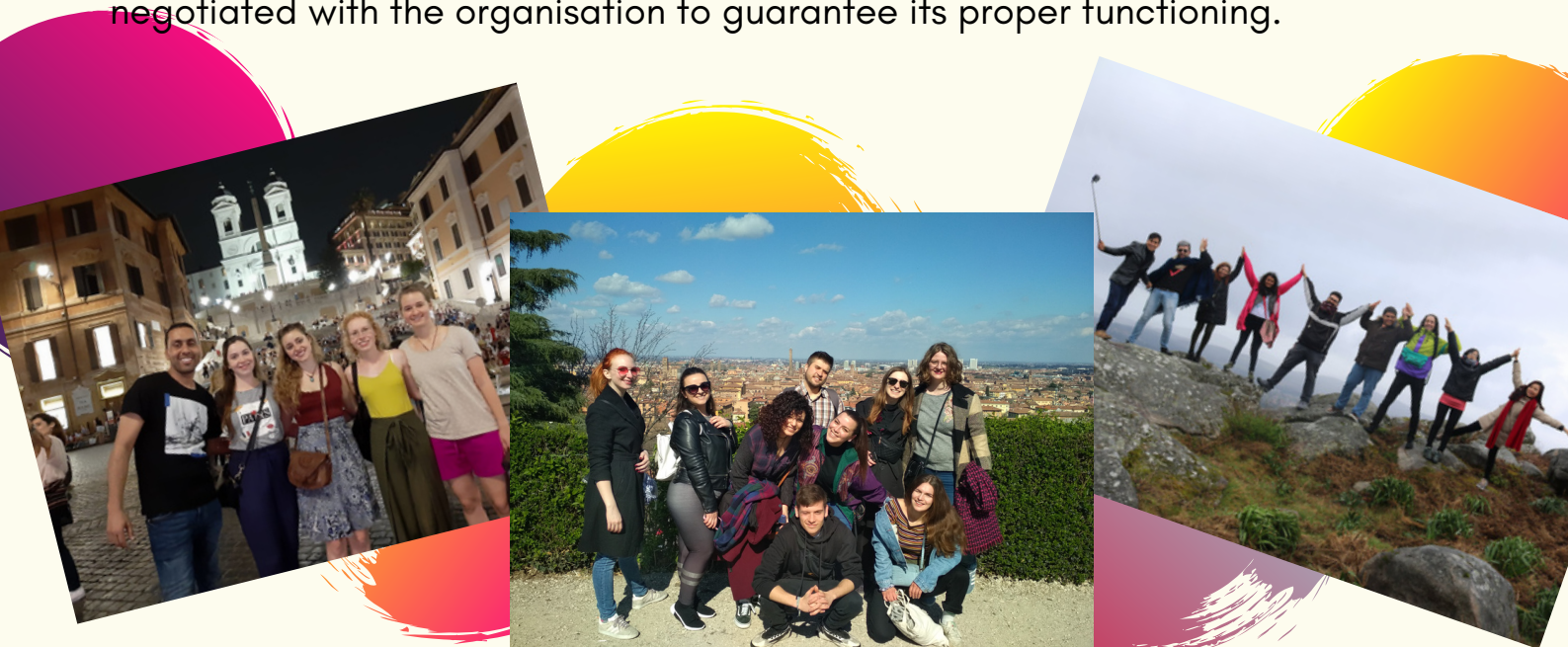
Accommodation: Volunteers will share the volunteer house, which includes four spacious double bedrooms complete with bed linens, offering a comfortable and relaxing space. In the communal lounge/kitchen, volunteers can gather and socialize. The house has one bathroom, equipped with a washing machine, and towels are provided.

Local transport: A bike will be available for volunteers to use to get to work and travel around Marotta.

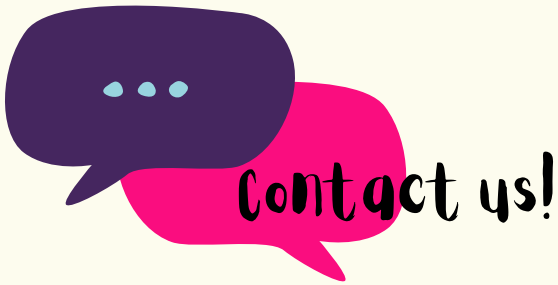
Food & Pocket money: volunteer will receive a total amount of 150 €/month for food and 5 €/day as pocket money. **This payment will be done via bank transfer every first day of the month*

Travel costs: travel expenses (round trip flight) will be reimbursed to the volunteer according to the distance band, from 180 to 820€. Bologna is the closest airport, but it is also possible to land in Milan, Venice or Rome and then take a train to Bologna.


Free days: during the project, volunteers will have two consecutive free days per week, as well as two additional free days per month. Holidays should be negotiated with the organisation to guarantee its proper functioning.





Language training: volunteers are welcome to learn Italian before and during their service. Volunteers will have access to OSL (Online Linguistic Support) so that they can start the course provided by Erasmus+ programme.

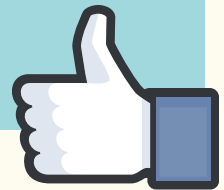
